1. LTI Registration. Generate LTI Key and Secret:

2. Approve apps.dataii.com as LTI tool domain. You may already have this domain approved.
 - a. Navigate to Admin Panel -> LTI Tool Providers -> Register LTI 1.1 Provider
 - b. The domain: **apps.dataii.com**

Content Tool Adoption: Using Content Tool for placements anywhere in the course with default assistant prompt with the course name and optional school affiliation. This adoption allows instructors to add the AI assistant in a few clicks:

Create placement “AI Class Assistant.”

3. After approving appd.dataii.com use chevron menu to select Manage Placements
4. Create a new placement
 - a. Label: **AI Instructor Assistant**
 - b. Description: Explore instructional resources and techniques for your course. Adopt the tools you find helpful.

- c. Handle: **dataiiai1**
 - d. Type: **Course Content Tool** (Allow grading should be disabled)
 - e. Tool Provider URL: **<https://apps.dataii.com/ai/instructor/>**
 - f. Tool Provider Key & Secret – as provided
 - g. Icon: https://apps.dataii.com/ai/images/dataii_ai_4_50px.png
