
Part 1. Basic LTI configuration.




- 3. After approving appd.dataii.com use chevron menu to select Manage Placements


- c. Handle: dataiiai1

- i. Optionally provide custom parameters for setting content to your institutions. The u parameter can be set to your school. Custom variables are optional.








5. The tool will be available in courses under Build Content -> AI Class Assistant. When instructors select it, they will put a placement link in their course, which will be available to their students.
